BAS will be moving to a four-day week for our face-to-face students with a virtual/online day for all students every Friday beginning on October 23 until further notice.

High School (Grades 9 - 12): Brimley Area Schools is providing face-to-face

instruction for students in grades K-12. BAS is also providing students with the opportunity to enroll in our Blue and White Virtual Academy. BAS will be moving to a four-day week for our face-to-face students with a virtual/online day for all students every Friday beginning on October 23 until further notice.
